### **QUALITY ASSURANCE INDICATORS**

- 3.2.4 When planning for play sessions, coordination unit staff thinks in advance about the interests of children, building on observations of the children and discussions with Carers and families
- 3.2.5 Play session planning takes into account various aspects of the learning environment. For example, the group dynamics, daily routines, space, materials, equipment and weather conditions
- 3.2.6 Over time, coordination unit staff provide both indoor and outdoor experiences at play sessions
- 3.2.7 Coordination unit staff evaluate the experiences provided for children at play sessions and record the children's responses to the environment as well as the children's ideas for the future experiences
